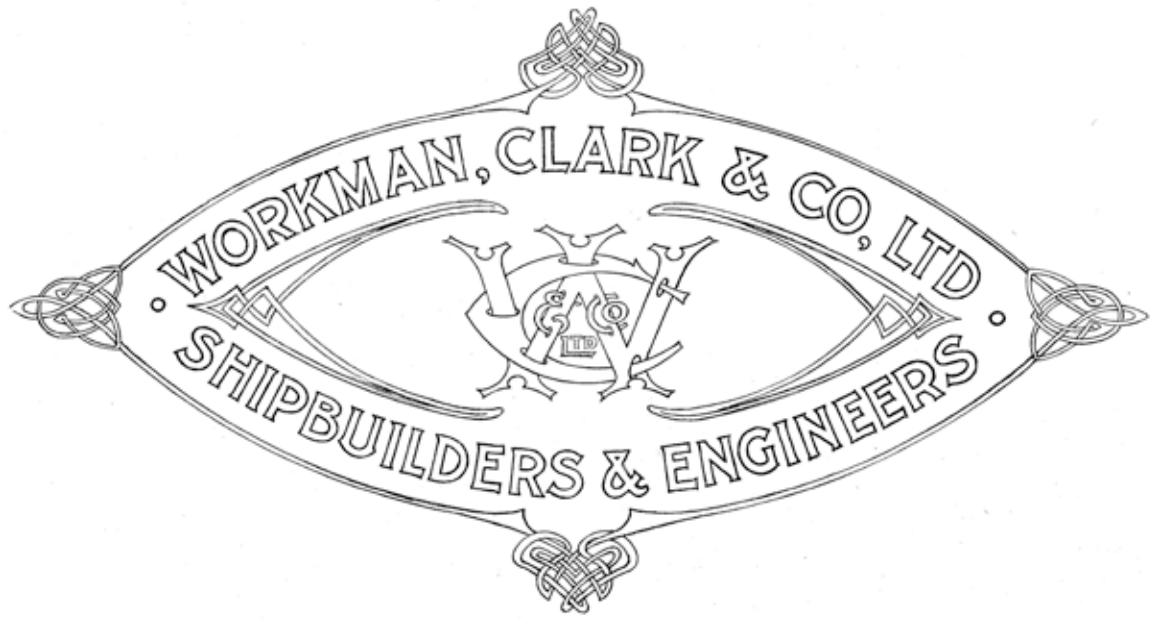
Gunner Samuel John Paisley McClure
of *Whiteabbey* was serving with "D" Battery, 108th Brigade, Royal Field Artillery when he was Killed in Action on 24th June 1917, aged 20, and is buried in Poperinghe New Military Cemetery, Belgium.

Private William Henry Pryce
of *Alexandra Park Avenue in the Duncairn Ward* was serving with 1st Battalion Cameron Highlanders when he was Killed in Action on 10th July 1916, aged 21, and is buried in Gordon Dump Cemetery, Ovillers-La Boisselle, France.

Rifleman Robert James Todd
of *Nelson Street in the Dock Ward* was serving with 1st Battalion Royal Irish Rifles when he was Killed in Action on 9th May 1915, aged 18, and is commemorated on the Ploegsteert Memorial, Belgium.

The memorial was commissioned by Frank Workman (co-founder of this shipyard) and his wife, Sara, in memory of their only son, Edward (Ted), and the officers and men of the Belfast Shipyard (fondly known as "The Wee Yard") who fell in the Great War. It was constructed by Purdy and Millard of Howard Street and Sophia Rosamond Praeger RA provided the terracotta relief of Ted Workman as the centrepiece and three relief panels. At time of unveiling it listed details of 122 men of the Workman Clark yard who gave their lives in the war. Later additions increased the memorial's final total to 136 men, although recent research indicates that nearly 100 men who lost their lives were associated with Workman Clark before the war. In addition, in excess of 20 men died in workplace accidents in this shipyard during the war period.

The memorial was unveiled by Sir Edward Carson on 8th August 1919 and was originally situated in a prominent position on the right-hand side of the main entrance to the Workman Clark head offices in their North Yard. The men would have passed the memorial every day on their way to work. When the Wee Yard closed in 1935, the main part of the memorial was relocated to the Pumphouse, where it stands today. Sadly, over the intervening century, severe erosion had made it impossible to read many of the names. In 2019, a project was initiated to protect the memorial and ensure the names of all of the 136 fallen were again known.

of *Somerset Street in the Ormeau Ward* was serving with 1st Battalion Irish Guards when he was Killed in Action on 19th May 1915, aged 32, and is commemorated on the Le Touret Memorial, France.

Private John Gilliland
of *Bryson Street in the Pottinger Ward* was serving with 4th Battalion Guards Machine Gun Regiment when he Died at No. 8 General Hospital on 9th May 1918, aged 25, and is buried in Bois-Guillaume Communal Cemetery Extension, France.

of *Weir Street in the Shankill Ward* was serving with 1/5th Battalion Seaforth Highlanders when he was Killed in Action on 18th September 1916, aged 18, and is buried in Cite Bonjean Military Cemetery, Armentieres, France.

of *Glasgow Street in the Duncairn Ward* was serving with 109th Field Ambulance Royal Army Medical Corps when he was Killed in Action on 8th August 1916, aged 20, and is buried in Berks Cemetery Extension, France.
